

The song is in 6/8 time - count it as "ONE two three TWO two three". Try this strumming pattern :

This is represented by chord names, and slashes : / Each chord name *or* slash means play for the count "**123**". So " **Em** / " would mean play Em for two lots of "123" (or "**1**23**2**23") Hope that makes sense!

Here's the chords I've used. They're not exactly the same as the original song, but they sound nice and are not too hard to play. TO BE IN THE SAME KEY AS ME YOU'LL NEED A CAPO AT THE 3rd FRET!

CHORUS (as before, finishing on one strum of G)
